and I hope that it will reach its destination safely and  
be productive of satisfaction to thee; were it only  
as a sign that year & long past are not forgotten, and  
that thy more than Motherly care and attention are still  
borne in mind by those towards whom they were exercised.

I am well to do in the world and am  
respected by those amongst whom my lot has been cast  
and owe thee more of thy education than to any thing  
else except Providence. I shall be happy to hear  
from thee, this letter is short but it is much longer  
than mine and the truth that I have written this day
